

# Christmas Lace



**Size:** 76 inches long, 5 inches wide.

**Materials:**

size 6 knitting needles  
2 skeins Inca Alpaca 109 yards/50 grams each  
tapestry needle for weaving in ends

**Gauge:** gauge is not critical as you will block to desired size

Abbreviations

**k:** knit  
**p:** purl  
**sl:** slip as if to purl  
**p2tog:** purl two stitches together  
**YO:** yarnover  
**pssso:** pass the slipped stitch over

Cast on 22 stitches.

Row 1: k3, \*YO, sl1, k1, pssso, k2; repeat from \* to last 3 stitches, YO, sl1, k1, pssso, k1

Row 2: p3, \*YO, p2tog, p2; repeat from \* to last 3 stitches, YO, p2tog, p1

Repeat these two rows until desired length ending with a row 2. Knit 1 row. Bind off and weave in ends. Soak in tepid water for 30 minutes. Lace blocking wires threaded through the outermost row of yarnovers on either side give a lovely even scarf. If you do not own blocking wires try threading a colorfast thread or string through the yarnovers instead.

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
