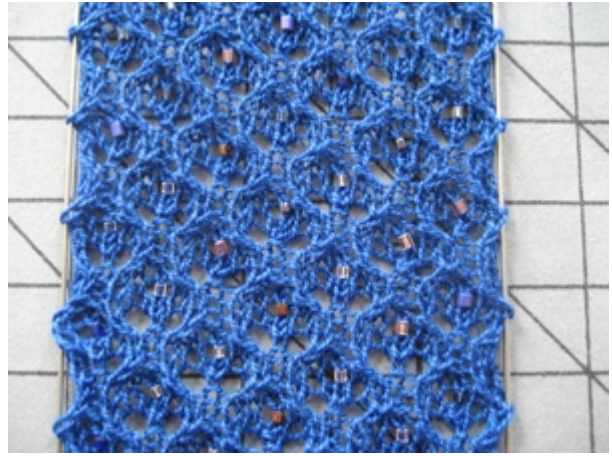


Delphinium



Size:
5" wide, 70" long

Materials: About 50 grams fingering weight yarn
Size 7 needle
tapestry needle for weaving in ends
Size 12 crochet hook
about 25 grams beads with a bore large enough to fit a double strand of your yarn (size 6 or 8 I think)

Gauge: gauge is not critical as you will block to desired size.

Abbreviations:

k: knit
p: purl
sl: slip
k2tog: knit the next two stitches together
yo: yarnover
pssso: pass the slipped stitch over the just knit stitch
bead: take the stitch just knit, slip it off the needle, place a bead onto your crochet hook and pull the stitch through the bead slipping it back onto the right needle
.*: repeat stitches between the asterisks across row

Cast on 25 stitches.

Pattern:

Row 1: sl1, k3, bead, k2, * p1, k3, bead, k2 *, k1
Row 2: sl1, * p5, k1 *
Row 3: sl1, * yo, sl1, k1, pssso, p1, k2tog, yo, k1 *
Row 4: sl1, p2, * k1, p5 *, k1, p2, k1
Row 5: sl1, k2, * p1, k3, bead, k2 *, p1, k3
Row 6: sl1, p2, * k1, p5 *, k1, p2, k1
Row 7: sl1, * k2tog, yo, k1, yo, sl1, k1, pssso, p1 *, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, sl1, k1, pssso, k1
Row 8: sl1, * p5, k1 *

Repeat rows 1-8 until your desired length is reached. Weave in ends and block gently as desired.

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
